Follow-instructions below for dressing care. 5. <u>Dressing or Bandage Care:</u> • Keep dressing clean and dry; do not change surgical dressings unless instructed to do so. 				
 6. Ice and Elevation Please place ice on top of the dressing for 35-45 minutes, 3-4 times per day. Continue for 3-5 days. Prepare ice in a waterproof bag. DO NOT place ice bag directly against skin. Elevate the leg on 2 pillows placed under the foot (not under knee). Continue this as often as possible for the first 72 hours to prevent blood clots. Continue to ice after 72 hours 3 times per day
